Water Sample Results for August 7th, 2018

We did our usual number of samples of Sturgeon Bay Water for Recreational purposes Tuesday August 7th. It was rather iffy as it had been a very hot, humid week leading up to Tuesday and a light rain overnight. By sample time, a moderate wind had small waves on the eastern shore and off shore calm at the western shore. Water temperature at all sites was 24 degrees and there was no indication of water fowl at our locations (we were several hours later than usual taking samples). All but Pine Street Beach had algae present.

Remember, any sample reading *below 100 e-coli / 100 ml water is considered safe for recreational purposes* although as the number gets closer to 100, young children or people with skin sensitivities should be cautious and towel dry upon leaving the water.
