Good morning All:

Saturday, July 8th, we did our 2nd Recreational Water Sampling of Sturgeon Bay and here are the results. Samples were taken between 11:45 am and 2pm and delivered to the Lab in Craighurst. The bay was mostly calm (light ripple at times) and 26 degrees at the 2 foot level. No water fowl, animals or people were observed at any of our sites.

Brown algae was present in all areas with rocks or wooden structures in the bay.
