

Water testing Report from Monday August 31, 2020

Hi Everyone,

It is hard to believe that tomorrow will be September! Time always goes by so fast during the summer months. Hopefully the warm weather will continue into September and October.

When I tested the water this week, it was a beautiful and sunny day. The water had some small waves and the air temperature was 20 degrees celsius. The wind direction was interesting today, as the water was calm on the Waubauskene side, but was windy and wavy on the Robin's Point side.

Here are the results from the water testing.

I do want to mention that there was seaweed in both #3 and #4. I did the testing beyond the seaweed. It is however the time of the season that a lot of seaweed is floating around in the bay. The water temperature at all of the locations was 22 degrees celsius.
