Hi All:

Just received our results for our Water Sampling done Tuesday, September 3rd. It was a calm day until the last 2 samples but that didn't effect them very much. Water temperatures were 18 degrees and little evidence of fowl except at #6 and #7 but, they were not present during my times there. All locations that had "in water rocks" had algae and including on the weeds in the water plus there was considerable silt at mot areas. I expect the good readings were helped by less than normal boating and swimming over the weekend meaning a settled underwater base.
