I just received the results for our water samples that were collected September 12<sup>th</sup> and turned into SGS Labs Canada Inc. Wednesday morning September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

To say the least, Sunday, Monday & Tuesday felt and looked more like summer than we had seen the past 2 months! Sunshine, calm water and clear skies finally found us and our readings are also very kind. Although Pine Street Beach had the highest readings, they were still well within the Provincial safety level for recreational use. There was evidence of Geese being in the area probably earlier in the day and a person had just brought in their Kayak to leave as I prepared to gather that sample. Location #6 (Robins Point Road) had a large # of Geese on the dock & in the water just north of our location. Location #5 (Lawson Lane) had a group of Ducks at that location. We did not sample Acorn Lane location this time.

Water was calm at all locations and 20 degrees Celcius.
